



BOOK EXCERPT

THE POINT

SPOILER ALERT!

If you don't remember anything else I say, I want you to know the whole point of God creating you and putting breath in your lungs is for you to experience His presence in your life. Psalm 46:1 says, "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble," (NIV). Ever-present help means God is always present to help you.

This book is like one of those movies that begins with the end scene, then jumps to a previous date in order for the whole movie to bring you back to the end scene. It takes the whole movie for the end scene to make sense. And it's the end scene that captures your attention and motivates you to keep watching.

I'm not waiting until the final chapter to tell you what is the point. This book represents one of the most impactful reveals of my life— in fact, the single biggest reveal ever, of anyone's life. No other reveal has the potential to change lives like this one. This is no doubt one of the biggest reveals in your life too. And that's why I'm starting right out of the gate with the whole point of this book. In fact, it is God's whole point of why you're alive in the first place. God's whole point is for you to experience His presence.

God's whole point is you in His presence and His presence in you.

Throughout the Bible, God has been making a point. It started in creation, continued in the Old Testament, through Psalms, and into the New Testament. God's point continues into the birth, life, miracles, death, burial, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus. It continues into the acts of the early Church and throughout the whole New Testament. God's whole point has been to give you His presence.

God's gift is His presence with you 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. God's point is not just about you praying the sinner's prayer. His point is not to give you some insurance policy from hell or to provide you with a label so you can call yourself a Christian. God's whole point is giving you His presence.

God's presence is His most valuable gift. Your presence is your most valuable asset. We talk about billable time. Some people get paid lots of money for their

presence. Regardless of an invoice, all children know the gift of their parents' presence. Spouses know the value of their spouse's presence. We also know if a person is truly present when they are present. We value people's presence! The same is true of God.

God knows the value of His presence. He could have offered you anything to demonstrate His love for you, but He offers you His presence. John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world, that he GAVE his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life," (ESV). The whole point is God giving us His presence.

God didn't send an employee, or a relative, or a representative. God sent Himself. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are one. God's whole point since the very beginning has been to give us the gift of His presence.

"SO WHAT?"

I love this question. Every Monday night I lead a small group Bible study and I regularly ask, "So what? Why did God have our pastor preach this message? Why is God leading us into these Scriptures? How do we apply this to our life?"

God's ultimate "so what?" is His presence in your life. God's "so what?" in creation is His presence in your life. The "so what?" of the Old Testament is God's presence in your life. The "so what?" of the Gospels of Jesus in Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John are all about God's presence in your life. The "so what?" of the New Testament is God's presence in your life. From cover to cover the "so what?" of the entire Bible is God's presence in your life.

The "so what?" of the Holy Spirit is God's presence in your life. In John 16:7 Jesus says something so radical it left His followers dumbfounded. Jesus said, "It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you," (NKJV). Just when His disciples are finally understanding His mission, Jesus announces that He will be going back to the Father after He is resurrected from the dead.

Everyone listening had to be thinking, "How is this good?" Finally, after hundreds of years, here is God with us and now He's leaving! Jesus is 100 percent God and 100 percent man. God is omnipresent, but Jesus had humbled himself to become a man. He is confined to His skin. He is confined to His geographic location. So, He says, "It is for your good that I go away because then I will send the Holy Spirit to you." The "so what?" is God's presence in your life.

God's whole point has been His presence in your life.

God has put His help on the inside of you.

It wasn't until I was thirty years old and had been in full-time ministry for over ten years that I understood the value of God's presence. God took me over 8,000 miles away to India and used India to change my life. In India I saw churches in thatch roof huts without bulletins, budgets, or Bibles, but they passionately pursued and experienced the presence of God. On the plane ride back from India, I committed to passionately pursuing the presence of God in my life too, and this choice changed my life more than being saved!

For the first two decades of my Christian life, I totally missed the point. I thought I had received salvation. This seemed more like an insurance policy protecting me from hell. It wasn't until I was thirty years old that I began to understand that God's whole point of salvation is His presence in our life. I knew my need for guidance. I used to cry out to God for His provision. But I had no idea about the value of God's presence. I pursued all the things of God, but I didn't pursue His presence. I totally missed the point!

God sent me into your life today to tell you to get to the point. So make sure you get to the point. It would be in your best interest to get to the point sooner rather than later too. You see, God is so wise. There is a point even to the point. Every guidance and provision you will ever need can be found today in His presence, which we will discuss in the next chapter.

So What?

God's whole point has always been His presence in your life.
